# Parent and Whānau Participation

We really appreciate that you are entrusting us to partner with you in your child's journey, and a strong relationship between us sends a positive message to your little one that they are loved by us all, and they belong here at Fame.

Great communication is key to this success, and we welcome your involvement and input.

We're always interested to hear your wishes and aspirations for your child, and also any way that you would like to contribute to our curriculum. This could be sending in resources, or arranging with our team to come and share your special skills or simply supporting your child by participating in our centre celebrations.

You'll hear from us frequently through conversations at drop-off and pick-up times, StoryPark messages (more on those next), emails, newsletters and notices posted in the centre.

#### Parent and Whānau Connections

We use StoryPark which is a wonderful online communication tool where we can share photos, videos and stories about exciting things your child will get up to at Fame.

We also use StoryPark to send you updates about things that are happening in the whole centre and in their individual groups, and for our younger children we track their routines too (sleeps, changes and feeds) so you can easily see what's happening while they are with us.

On enrolment, if you already use StoryPark we can continue with your exiting account, or we'll send you a link to your new free account which is private to you, and you can choose who you want to share it with in your own family.

You'll be able to add your own photos or videos, and comment on posts that we add as well. All of this will build a beautiful story of the time your child is with us at Fame.

We will also keep a lot of this progress in a physical folder for you and your child to enjoy looking through their fun and learning together. This will become a beautiful keepsake when they head off to school.

# Our Programme

Each of our age groups have dedicated teachers looking after their care and development. Your child will belong to a group with others of a similar age, and enjoy a happy balance of free-choice activities and routines which are appropriate for their stage and development.

We are inspired by best teaching practices from around the world, including Reggio Emilia, Gardner (especially his theory of multiple intelligences), Magda Gerber's RIE, and Carl Orff's child-centred approach to music.

We follow the New Zealand Early Childhood Curriculum, Te Whāriki to guide our planning based on the five strands: Wellbeing, Belonging, Contribution, Communication and Exploration.

# A Mix of Ages Together

For most of the day, your child will be free to explore and connect with older and younger children, and enjoy activities together, while supported by their teachers.

We love having a true family environment where siblings and cousins are able to be together, and tuakana-teina relationships are fostered. This is where younger children learn from older role-models, and they in turn learn valuable life skills such as caring for others, and taking leadership roles within the centre.

#### **Mealtimes**

We provide a nutritious range of food for morning and afternoon teas, and children bring their own food from home for lunch time. All food needs to meet the Ministry of Health's regulations as stated in their publication "Reducing food-related choking for babies and young children at early learning services", and this will be provided to you on enrolment.

#### **Under 2 Years**

Your little one will be loved and cared for by gentle and respectful teachers with fantastic ratios, in a calm, home-like environment.

You'll have a key teacher who will work with our other teachers to take you through your settling in process. They will build trusting relationships with your child, through consistent and meaningful interactions, so that they feel safe and happy with us.

We know it's a big deal to entrust the care of your child with us, so your teacher will also support you to be confident that your little one will be OK!

We'll talk with you regularly about routines and rituals that you have at home, and reflect these as much as possible here, to ensure consistency and predictability.

The Under 2s room will be their base for mealtimes and activities, and we have a dedicated sleep room to ensure they have a peaceful sleep time.



#### 2 to 5 Years

Your preschooler will have an exciting program of fun activities at Fame, and enjoy an ideal balance between self-directed play, and learning time routines. They'll be cared for by experienced and loving teachers, who will ensure they are engaged, learning, and having lots of fun during each day with us.

At certain times of the day, they will join others of a similar age for fun group times. Our teachers take this opportunity to extend their learning and develop their confidence.

Initially this will include songs, stories, rhymes and games that encourage children to join in and understand more about who they are and how they fit into the world around them.

As they grow, we will identify their interests, and develop projects with them to offer opportunities for research and to explore new ideas that excite them.

We all learn best when we are interested in something, and we find this project work to be a very effective way to incorporate all the early literacy, numeracy and problem-solving skills that they will need when they transition to school.

We also have a strong focus on dispositions for learning such as kindness, creativity, perseverance, responsibility, courage and many more – these are so important in developing your child into a life-long-learner and a wonderful person.

## **Creative Arts**

Our special focus on the arts will give your child many opportunities to have fun, and learn to express themselves creatively.

Each morning during term time our teachers lead groups for music, movement and drama sessions to develop their co-ordination, rhythm, musicality and confidence.

Music involves practically every part of a child's brain and creates far-reaching benefits in all areas of their cognitive development. We believe that our strong focus in this area is a key advantage children have at Fame.

Visual arts are also explored in depth through a huge range of mediums and provocations that will inspire your child to create.

At the end of each term, we host an arts celebration for our community which is alternately a performance, or an exhibition where we share some of the exciting singing, dancing and visual arts we've been working on together.

# Fees & Hours

We are open to care for children from **8.00am to 5.30pm, Monday to Friday**, all year except for statutory holidays, and around 2 weeks over the Christmas period.


All children from 3-6yrs qualify for the 20hrs ECE funding which reduces our fees as below.

Some families will be eligible for an income-tested **WINZ Subsidy**, and we are happy to help you with an application for this funding. We are not able to claim both the ECE hours and WINZ subsidy for the same hours.

# **Enrolment and Settling In**

To enrol with us, please complete an enrolment form which is available from our office or can be emailed to you.

We will also need the following:

- Child's ID birth certificate or passport
- Immunisation information
- Proof of your address

We'll advise you of spaces available and agree together on a timetable for your enrolment. If a space is not available straight away, we'll pop you on our waiting list and keep you up to date regularly.

The next step is to start some short visits to give you and your child some time to get to know our centre and build trust and confidence with our team.

Every child is different, but settling in usually takes around 2 weeks of short sessions. We start with an hour where you can stay with us, and then gradually extend the time each visit until you are happy to start the full timetable.

If you have a date that you need to be ready for, let us know so we can aim for that.

This is a flexible process, and we'll work on an individual plan that suits your needs and availability, as well as your child's age and confidence.
